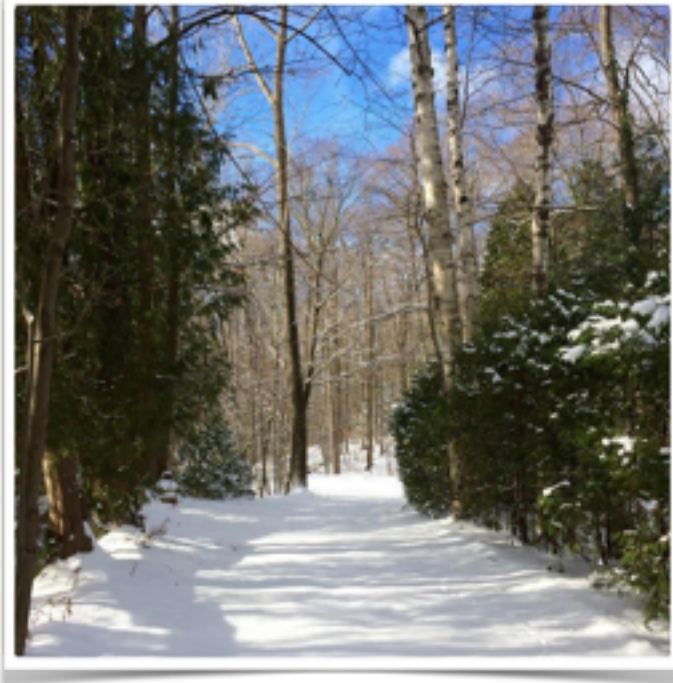

The Board has stated that post-dated cheques past the due date will have regular interest charges applied. As stated in M.O.M. overdue accounts will have interest applied at 2% per month.

**Melt-in-your-mouth Shortbread**

1 cup butter, softened  
 1/2 cup confectioners' sugar  
 1/4 cup cornstarch  
 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour

Preheat the oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C).

Whip butter with an electric mixer until fluffy. Stir in the confectioners' sugar, cornstarch, and flour. Beat on low for one minute, then on high for 3 to 4 minutes.

Drop cookies by spoonfuls 2 inches apart on an ungreased cookie sheet.

Bake for 12 to 15 minutes in the preheated oven. Watch that the edges don't brown too much. Cool on wire racks.
